

MINUTES OF ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING  
of  
CALIFORNIA WOMAN'S "500" BOWLING CLUB

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 P.M. on May 24, 1969 by Agnes Duffy, President of the California Woman's Bowling Association and temporary chairman of the Organizational meeting held in the Balboa Room of the Disneyland Hotel, Anaheim, California.

A poll was taken of City association "500" Clubs which were represented. The results of the poll were: San Luis Obispo, Los Angeles, Salinas, Marin County, Santa Rosa, Monterey, Petaluma, Missile Cities, Ventura, Stockton, San Fernando Valley, Clear Lake, San Gabriel Valley, Alameda, Antelope Valley, Sequoia, Orange County, And Santa Barbara.

Sign-up sheets were distributed for the signatures of those present. 100 members affixed their signatures to the circulated sheets.

STANDING RULES

The temporary chairman presented in draft form the standing rules under which the State 500 Club would function. The following specific actions were taken in connection with the proposed rules:

Re: ELIGIBILITY.

It was moved by Maxine Blanchette, seconded by Pat Talamantes, that standing rule 3 (c) read as follows: A member of the State 500 Club is automatically ineligible when she bowls more than one 600 series. It will be incumbent upon the member to notify the State 500 Club secretary-treasurer of the second 600 series within thirty (30) days of the date on which said second 600 series was bowled. Under these circumstances, membership in the State 500 Club cannot be re-established until the year book average of the member falls below 150 and is then followed by the bowling of what shall be designated a "new" 500 series. Motion carried.

It was moved by Barbara Sampson, Foothill WBA, seconded by Phyllis Glass, Salinas WBA, that an individual shall also be considered ineligible for membership in the State 500 Club if she is currently a member of a City, State, or National 600 Club, unless she qualifies under the reestablishment condition set forth in section (c) of Standing Rule 3. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Elsie Bodnar, Los Angeles WBA, seconded by Maxine Blanchette, Los Angeles WBA, that a State 500 Club be formed under the Standing Rules presented, including all changes necessary when drafting said rules in final form. Motion carried.
